Vaccinate against Rabies & Donate the Sales

For the month of September, donate a percentage of all rabies vaccinations (and/or products) sales to the Rabies Campaign.

Schedule weekly by-donation Nail-clipping Clinics

Run weekly nail-clipping clinics for the month of September or one clinic on World Rabies Day. Donate the proceeds to Help Make Rabies History!

Use Donation Box & Collect for the Rabies Campaign

Put a donation box on your counter for the month of September. Ask your local grocery/pet food store to do the same. As an incentive, enter donors into a prize draw.

Run a Raffle/50-50

Sell raffle tickets or 50-50 tickets. Ask a local business to donate products or a local sports team to donate tickets to raffle off as prizes.

Walk dogs, & Pet sit for Donations

Offer to walk a dog or look after a friend's pet (or plants) and ask the person who benefits from your actions for a donation towards your worthy cause. You can perform other free services for donations too: Rake leaves, gardening, face painting, pet washing, car washing.

Host & cook an International dinner:

Ask your friends/coworkers to cook traditional foods from a region(or regions) where VWB/VSF rabies prevention programs run (Chile, Guatemala, India, Malawi, Nepal, Northern Canada). Donate the dinner admission fee.

Hold a Sale

Bake some cookies, paint some pictures, knit some crafts, clear up some bookshelves, hold a yard sale and donate your earnings to the Rabies Campaign.

Hold a Pet Photo Contest

Ask people to pay to submit favourite pet photos to win a prize. You could display the photos in your clinic, online using flickr or a facebook page and ask people to vote for the winner.

Organize a petting zoo

If you live in an area in which there are farms nearby, organize a one-day petting zoo for children. Charge admission, sell refreshments and donate the proceeds to the Rabies Campaign.

Guess the number of doggy biscuits (how many are in the jar)

Fill a jar with doggy biscuits and ask people to guess how many are in the jar. For each guess people donate to the campaign. You could use candies, pennies, paperclips.

Dog bakery

Ask coworkers to bake dog treats and hold a dog bakery on World Rabies Day.

Host & cook an International dinner

Ask your friends/coworkers to cook traditional foods from a region(or regions) where VWB/VSF run rabies prevention programs (Chile, Guatemala, India, Malawi, Nepal, Northern Canada). Donate the dinner admission fee.

Beat the goalie

Pick the best hockey or soccer goalie you know (perhaps from local sports teams) and invite people to try to score a goal for a prize. Every participant has to pay to play.

Dog Walk-a-thon (or regular walk-a-thon, swim-a-thon, bike-a-thon)

Pick a date in September, choose a route, make up some pledge forms, and advertise with posters and online. Have everyone who wants to participate gather donations or pledges using their pledge forms.
